- Have a relevant higher education (at least three years of study)
- Are between 25 40 (born 1985 2000)

- Are currently employed in one of the following groups:
 - 1. Policymakers (politicians, government officials, employees of political parties)
 - 2. Public servants (non-political civil servants working at public organisations)
 - 3. Civil society workers (CSO/NGO employees)
- Have the mandate, ambition and potential to drive change within your organisation and home country
- Your professional profile is relevant for the thematic content of the module of your choice

Tountry-Specific Eligibility

• Armenia, Moldova, Ukraine

Applicants may come from **either civil service or civil society**. All applicants must demonstrate a **clear commitment to public governance reform**.

• Azerbaijan, Belarus, Georgia

Only applicants from **civil society** are eligible. Applications from civil servants in these countries will not be considered. All applicants must demonstrate a **clear commitment to public governance reform**.
